What You'll Do

Under the leadership of the Director, Finance and Treasury, the Accountant performs a variety of accounting and treasury functions. Specifically, the position ensures appropriate monthly and annual financial statements and reports are prepared for review and participates in the preparation of the annual operating and capital budget. The role monitors accounting systems and procedures in place throughout the credit union. Furthermore, the Accountant responds to a variety of requests for information and provides assistance/coverage for other related accounting and treasury functions. The position will provide assistance and coverage for the accounting team; therefore, the incumbent must be familiar with the key responsibilities of other finance positions.

What Does the Ideal Candidate Bring?

The preferred candidate has completed a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting or a related field and working towards CPA designation, with a minimum of 1-2 years' experience in a similar role. The successful incumbent will have working knowledge of accounting standards and taxation, with strong proficiency in the Microsoft Office Suite. Experience with programming language, accounting or banking software, and/or working knowledge of banking regulatory requirements would all be considered assets.
